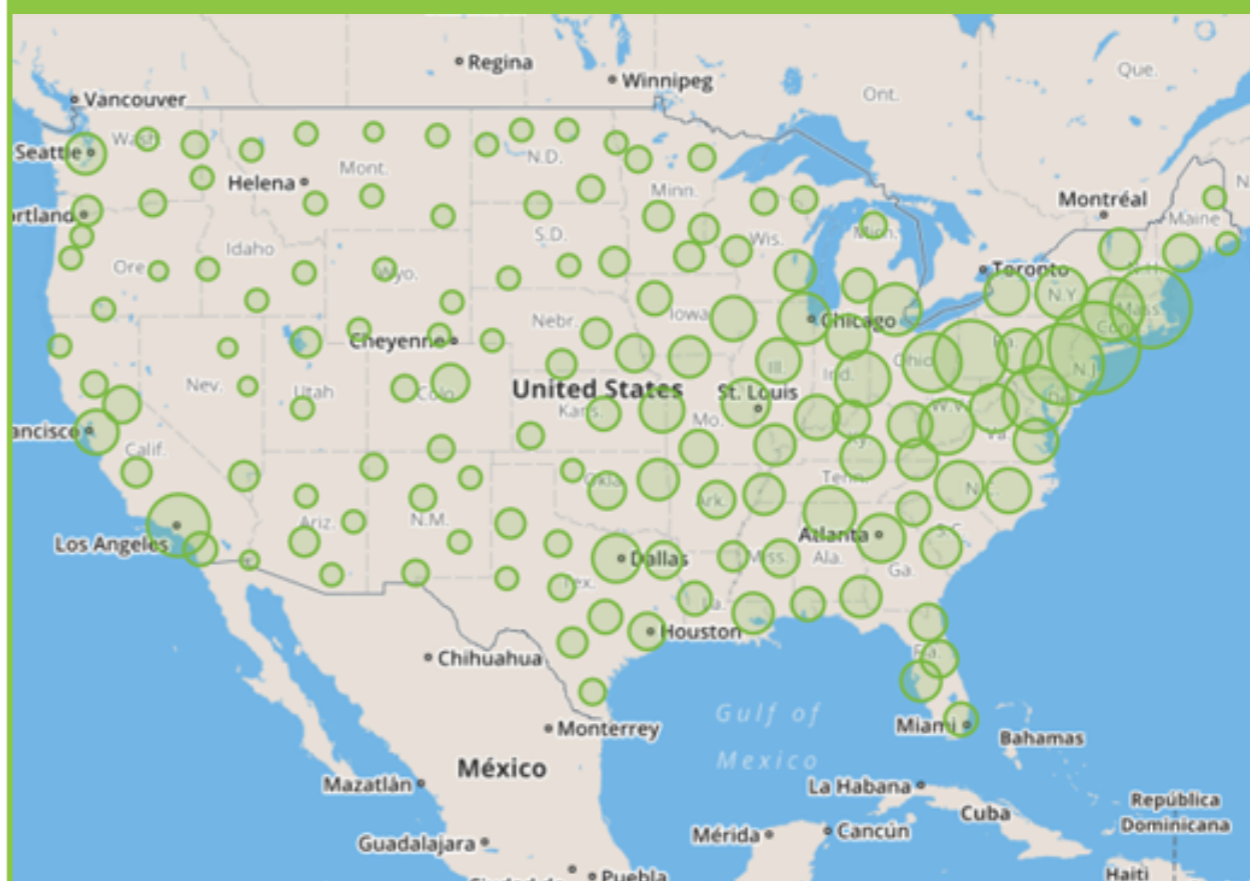

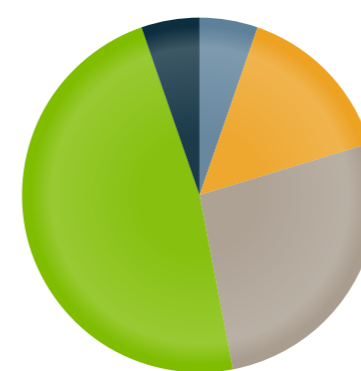
DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOLS
