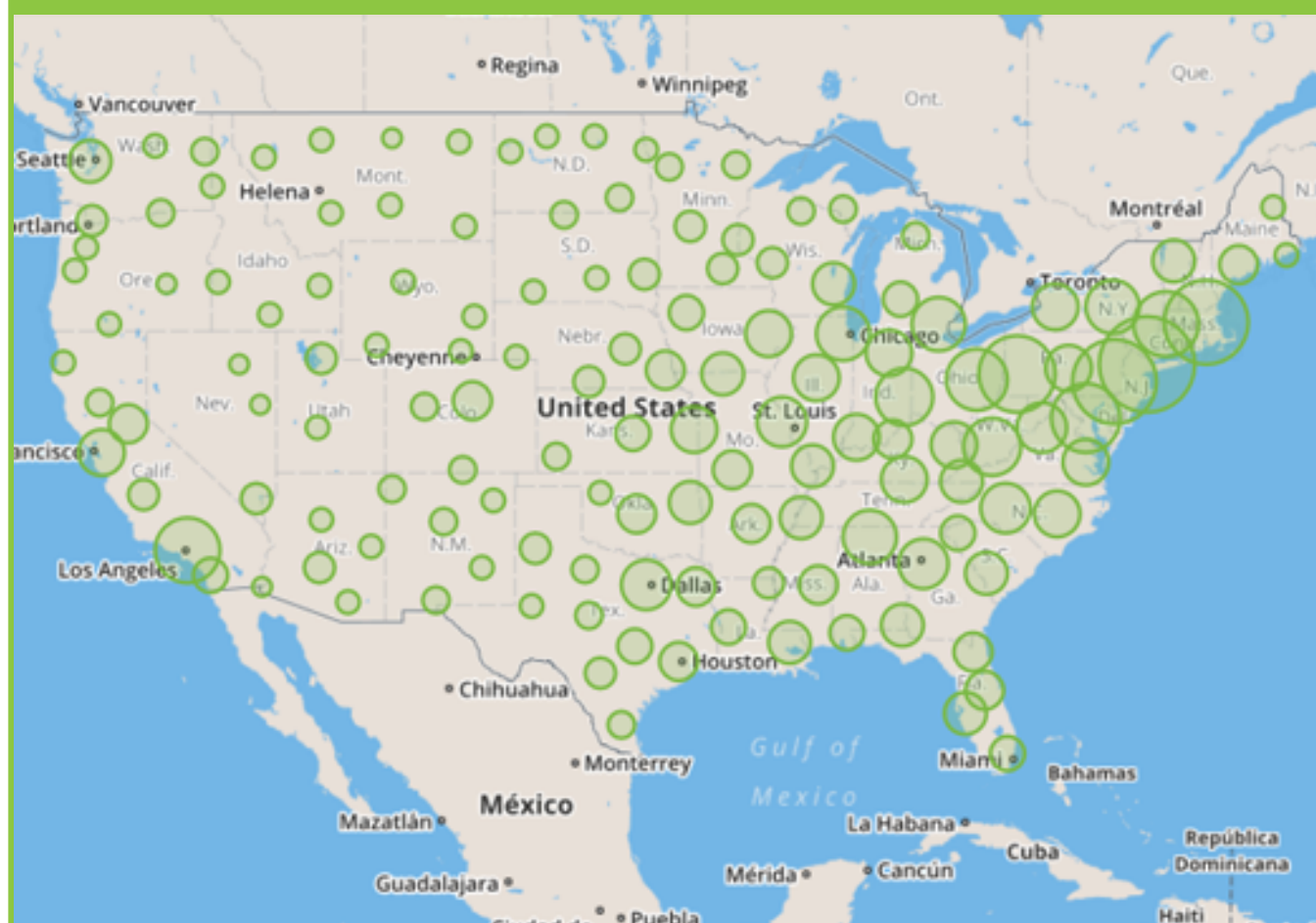

■ Elementary ■ Middle ■ High ■ Other/Combined

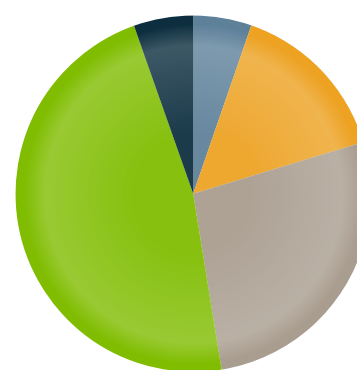
DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOLS
